

- Sergio, Chaves Instructor
- Professor Chaves explained material well, and was always willing to answer questions. My only comment would be that there were multiple occasions where a problem on a homework assignment (and once on an exam) was incorrect as stated. Many of times, it was a small detail that was missing, which made figuring out the problems were incorrect quite difficult, as I would often be unsure if I was missing something, or if the problem was missing a hypothesis. However, Professor Chaves always answered emails regarding assignments, and always was willing to help in these situations (either by re-writing the problem if it was missing something, or by giving a hint if it wasn't).
- Great professor. Loved that he encouraged students to participate and suggest the idea for a proof prior to proving/explaining theorems/examples.
- Professor Chaves's lectures were clear and the assignments were good at giving us practice using the topics we covered in class. One thing that was a little bit hard to follow was when Professor Chaves provided a brief summary of a proof verbally but didn't write anything on the board, because it was easy to miss important details.
- Sergio Chaves was really an excellent professor. He really made himself available for questions even outside his office hour time. Sometimes, I would email him asking if we could hop on a zoom call quickly to discuss something and he would always be willing to do this. Also, he really emphasized class participation. Instead of lecturing and filling in all of the details of the lecture himself, he would always engage with the class to see if we could figure out the details of the proof or try to figure what approach to take. This style of teaching really helped with my understanding of the material and helped me stay on track with the material.





(Text/Memo)

- My main comment on the course would be the material near the end. The assignments on algebraic topology, and the algebraic topology material in general, while being incredibly interesting, was very difficult, much more difficult than any of the other material in the course (which was already quite difficult). I myself feel that, as an undergraduate taking a first course in topology, I was not ready to learn algebraic topology, and would have benefitted from learning more undergraduate point set topology, saving algebraic topology for a graduate course.
- I really enjoyed how this class was structured. We started off on a slow pace and we gradually sped up in pace as the material became more challenging. Since this speedup was gradual, I never felt there was a point that I was immediately stressed out or worried about my ability to keep pace.
