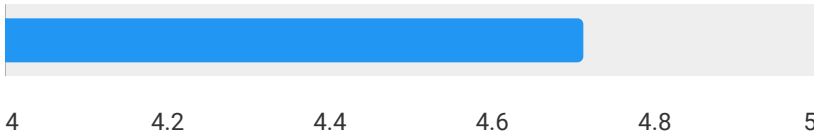

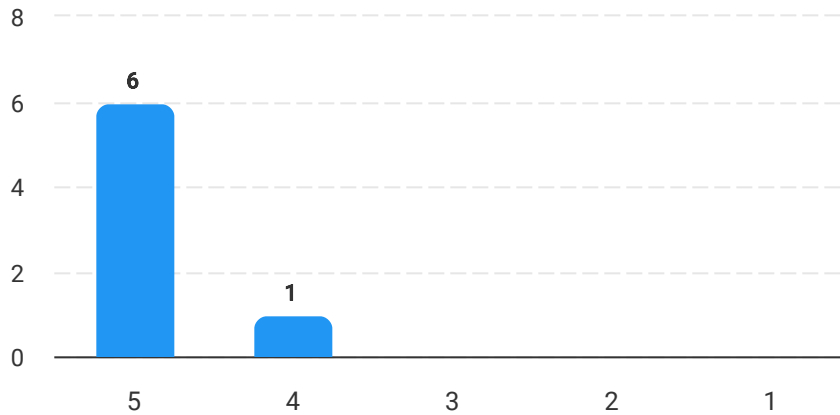

- It's a tough course. But also makes a lot of sense.
- I think it would be easier if the homeworks were due mid-week. With the Sunday deadlines, I would rarely have time to work on the latest homework until Friday and at that point all of the professors' office hours had already come and gone. The few times the homework was due mid-week, it was much nicer, I was able to work on the homework over the weekend and then go to office hours with any lingering questions I had.
